



Tusk Thumb Warmer Instructions

Attention: This heater is intended to be used with the “Tusk Handlebar Grip Heater Kit with Molded Grips”, part # 1349320001.

Instructions

Caution: Do not cut or needlessly flex the heating element.

1. Clean the thumb throttle using contact cleaner or brake cleaner to eliminate any dirt, grease, or oil. Do not cut away the stock rubber cover on the throttle if it exists.
2. Remove the paper backing from the heating element and press the heating element on the throttle where your thumb will usually touch.
3. Slide the shrink tubing over the throttle. Using a heat gun (preferred), lighter, or match; heat the shrink the tubing. Make sure the heat is applied evenly (you may need to remove the throttle from the handlebar to achieve this).
4. Carefully route the wires along the handlebars making sure they don't interfere with throttle movement or with other controls.
5. Refer to the wiring diagram below for final wiring. Note the thumb warmer's female lead plugs directly into the switch's male lead. The right grip lead then plugs into the thumb warmer's male lead.
6. Fasten wires to the machine (handlebar, frame, etc.) with zip-ties or electrical tape. Make sure wiring does not interfere with steering or other controls.
